BIOGRAPHY:

Clements, a member of the National Sculptors' Guild, has a Masters Degree in sculpture. Over the years, many influences, interests and commissions have combined to create a diverse body of work. He has completed over 120 sculptures, of which over 30 were commissioned by major corporations, municipalities, and private collectors.

An exciting area of Clements' career has been large-scale commissions designed and placed with the National Sculptors' Guild (NSG) design team. As an artist with diverse sculptural interests, he explores concepts for design from different cultures, images and philosophies. Then, using his knowledge of abstract design combined with his extensive background in producing representational sculpture Clements creates site-specific pieces that stand the test of time.

"The Desert Holocaust Memorial" in Palm Desert is an example of Clements' use of powerful figurative sculpture in conjunction with strong architectural configuration by the NSG design team.

Another NSG design team project integrating architecture with sculpture is the site-specific sculpture "Leap of Faith", depicting a ski jumper cantilevered from the wall between two escalators into the atrium of the 2001 Olympic Headquarters. Recently Clements completed the "Perfect Ice Collection" containing eight life-size skaters for the City of Paramount, CA.

Other placements of monumental sculpture include Mountain View, CA; Cerritos, CA; Black Hawk, CO; at the Omaha Botanical Gardens and Santa Fe Springs, CA. He is currently working on a site-specific commission in Atlanta, GA.
